**Assignment: Interoperability (due in two weeks)**

- Executive summary
- Main report that should cover the details of what it is, the gist of how it works, what is working, and what are the barriers.

Your report be written based on

- At least 2 research articles
- Total of at least 5 sources including the 2 research articles. Add this in the appendix (Approximately first 15 pages. Add a link to the full source, if longer.)

This is learning activities 3 in Chapter 3 (pg 94) in the textbook.

Conduct a literature review on interoperability in health care.

What challenges lie ahead?

How do you think we may overcome these challenges?
